We are looking forward to seeing you in Flagstaff for the 35th Annual WRHC conference. This letter serves as your final confirmation, including very important information about the conference and Flagstaff.

Check-in:

The High Country Conference Center is located at the southeast corner of the Butler Ave and Milton Road intersection. There are two buildings on this corner, the 6-story (as yet unfinished) hotel, and the conference center (the conference center is behind the hotel). A weblink to a map is listed on the conference's "Conference Center and Hotel Information" page.

Conference check-in will be held in the main lobby of the Conference Center from 3-7pm on Thursday; 7:00am-4:00pm on Friday; and 8-11am on Saturday.

Our Flagstaff-as-Text experience will begin at 4pm on Thursday and last an hour and a half to two hours. Come explore Flagstaff with us!

Please be advised that Flagstaff is at 7,000 feet elevation. The air is thin and weather can be unpredictable—it can snow in early April or it can be 65 degrees and sunny. Be prepared—Flagstaff's elevation makes sunburns more prevalent and the air is often quite dry. Flagstaff is also a very walkable town, so even if you're not participating in the Flagstaff-As-Text experience on Thursday, you'll want comfortable walking shoes to do some exploring.
