I am pleased to announce that the University is now inviting nominations of tenured professors from all NAU campuses and disciplines for Regents' Professor. Nominations are due to the University Provost no later than Monday, August 29, 2011.

Any tenured or tenure-track faculty member may nominate a qualified individual by submitting a completed nomination form ([http://home.nau.edu/provost/faculty\\_info.asp](http://home.nau.edu/provost/faculty_info.asp)) and the nominee's curriculum vitae. Self nominations are not accepted.

Appointment as a Regents' Professor is one of the highest honors that the university bestows on its faculty. The title is reserved for faculty with truly exceptional achievements that have brought them national and/or international distinction and whose work is of superior quality according to standards set by leading scholars in the field. Nominees must also be teachers of exceptional ability who have interests and accomplishments extending beyond a particular specialty.

Regents' Professors are expected to serve as advisors to the President and Provost, as well as to be available for activities throughout the university system.
